



Project History

- In late 2020 a citizen group proposed a splash park be built in an empty downtown city lot.
- Parks board voted to support the downtown splash pad project (02/17/2021)
- City Council voted unanimously to adopt a resolution of support to explore use of the vacant city lot for a splash park. (04/19/2021)
- City staff engaged Bolton & Menk to prepare an initial concept and cost estimate.
- The Main Street committee offered to raise \$400,000.
- The Legacy Plaza reinvestment grant application included Newton's planned private/public investment in this vacant lot for a future splash pad and park.
- Main Street Designer updated the park design May 6, 2022, based on public feedback the committee received while fundraising.
