

## Our Vision

Newton, the proud county seat of Jasper County, is a thriving community. Our centrally located, historic downtown defines our character and culture. Downtown Newton is a visually stimulating showplace and a vibrant district with diverse shopping, dining, living, and entertainment.

A cohesive design plan and complementing financial incentives encourage property owners to invest in their buildings and respect a balance between downtown's historic integrity, modern elements, and improvements. A recently completed downtown streetscape incorporates sustainable practices, honors our community's history, and enhances downtown as our central gathering place.

Newton Main Street is the hub for communication, community buy-in, local partnerships, and strong local leadership. A clear, implementation-oriented plan continually shows progress and demonstrates success.

A full calendar of multi-generational activities provides a mix of retail and special events that draw residents and visitors day and night. Each year our signature downtown event highlights the best our community has to offer and builds upon our strong downtown image as a hometown community with a base of diverse entertainment options.

New quality downtown living opportunities offer live-work space, market-rate, and affordable upper-floor residential options. Downtown residents, visitors, and local citizens support locally owned businesses and restaurants. Local business resources support independent entrepreneurship, help maintain anchor businesses, like our locally owned theater, and aid in the recruitment of destination business opportunities.

Downtown Newton is distinctively different and a perfect opportunity to get to know Newton.

### Partners

In 2014, Newton received the Main Street Iowa Community designation from the Iowa Economic Development Authority. The mission of the Main Street Iowa Program is to improve the social and economic well-being of Iowa communities by assisting over 50 selected communities to capitalize on the unique identity, assets and character of their downtown area.

## Four Point Approach

The Main Street Four Point Approach<sup>®</sup> is a trademarked program of the National Trust for Historic Preservation's Main Street Center. It offers a comprehensive and integrated strategy for commercial district revitalization using four key facets.

#### **ORGANIZATION**

Brings together the public sector, private groups, and individual citizens to work together more effectively in support of the local program.

#### **ECONOMIC VITALITY**

Diversifies the historic district's economy by identifying potential market niches, finding new uses for vacant or under-used spaces, and improving business practices.

#### **DESIGN**

Utilizes appropriate design and preservation concepts to enhance the visual quality of the district (buildings, signs, window displays, landscaping, and environment).

#### PROMOTION

Encourages a community to focus on the district as a source of community pride, social activity, and economic development potential.



## The District

The boundaries shown on the left indicate the Newton Main Street District. This area encompasses the core historic commercial district, Legacy Plaza, city municipalities, county government buildings, and art centers. The businesses and buildings located in this district are the primary focus of the Newton Main Street's mission and as a State Certified Main Street, are eligible for additional grant funding and services through the local main street program.
